KUALA LUMPUR: Daya Materials Bhd says its unit, Daya Proffscorp Sdn Bhd, has inked an agreement with Italy's Cimolai Technology SpA to undertake a "Mobile Straddle Transporter MST 320" project used in lifting and transportation.
